FINAL INFORMATION

The Championship races are taking place in Pittencrieff Park, Dunfermline KY12 8QH.

Parking :

There is a small amount of parking, including coach space, in Pittencrieff Park from the Pittencrieff Street entrance. **PLEASE DO NOT TAKE VEHICLES TO THE PAVILION AREA.**

Other parking is available which is within 5 minutes walking distance from the Park –

Glen Bridge Car Park KY12 8DF (including coach space)

St. Margaret's Street Car Park KY12 7PE, and

Other street parking near Dunfermline Abbey KY12 7PE

Tesco, Winterthur Lane – KY12 7BD – free parking for up to two hours.

After arriving in Pittencrieff Park, the Adult in charge of each school should make their way to the Pavilion, to declare their teams and collect the School envelope which will include the athletes number – the envelope must be signed for.

Race 1A – Boys P6 – Approx. 1600m – 11.45 am start

Race 2 – Girls P7 – Approx. 1600m – 12 noon start

Race 2A – Boys P7 – Approx. 1600m – 12.15 pm start

Declarations for the Primary School Races close 30 minutes before start of race

GROUP D

Race 3 – Girls (born on or after 1/03/12) – Approx. 2400m – 12.30 pm start

Race 4 – Boys (born on or after 1/03/12) – Approx. 2400m – 12.45 pm start

Declarations for Group D races close at 12 noon and 12.15 pm respectively

GROUP C

Race 5 – Girls (born 1/03/11 – 28/02/12) – Approx. 2400m – 1 pm start

Race 6 – Boys (born 1/03/11 – 28/02/12) – Approx. 2400m – 1.15 pm start

Declarations for Group C races close at 12.30 pm and 12.45 pm respectively.

PARA ATHLETES

Race 7 - Para Athletes from P6 to U20 in education or training –
Approx. 2400m – 1.30 pm start

Declarations for this race close 1 pm

GROUP B

Race 8 – Girls (born 1/03/09 – 28/02/11) – Approx. 3200m - 1.45 pm start

Race 9 – Boys (born 1/03/09 – 28/02/11) – Approx. 4800m – 2.05 pm start

Declarations for Group B races close at 1.15 pm and 1.35 pm respectively

GROUP A

Race 10 – Girls (born on or before 28/02/09) – Approx. 3200m – 2.25 pm start

Race 11 – Boys (born on or before 28/02/09) – Approx. 4800m – 2.45 pm start

Declarations for Group A races close at 1.55 pm and 2.15 pm respectively

The timings are approximate.

Please bring your own pins.

Bags can be left within the Pavilion. PLEASE PLACE ALL RUBBISH IN THE BAGS PROVIDED OR TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU.

Toilets are available within the Pavilion and within the park.

The course will be open for viewing from 10.30 am.

Assembly for each race will be intimated and pupils should make their way to the start area near the pavilion,

Course Maps will be on view in the Pavilion and outside areas.

Please ensure that all race competitors stay off the course when the event starts (unless of course they are in that race)

Presentations will be made as soon as possible after the result is finalised.

The first 3 finishers in each race will receive a medal and a trophy will be awarded to the top team in each race (4 runners to count for a team).

Entry fees should have already been sent by BACS or a cheque made payable to SSAA sent to Sandra Hardacre

NB Pittencrieff Park paths will be open to the public during our event, and we are all asked to be courteous at all times to other Park users.
